- Shakespeare's parents were probably illiterate, and his children almost certainly were.
- Nobody knows what Shakespeare did between 1585 and 1592.
- Shakespeare's plays feature the first written instances of hundreds of familiar terms.
- We probably don't spell Shakespeare's name correctly—but, then again, neither did he.
- Shakespeare's epitaph wards off would-be grave robbers with a curse.
- Shakespeare wore a gold hoop earring—or so we think.
- North America's 200 million starlings have Shakespeare to thank for their existence.
- Some people think Shakespeare was a fraud.





SHE: Because you are ugly and stupid and old.


